

These terms and conditions (“Conditions”) apply to the Lockdown Heroes (“Competition”)

By nominating/entering into these awards, you agree to be bound by these Conditions.

The promoter of these Awards is Greater Manchester Higher, Manchester Metropolitan University Manchester M15 6BH (“Promoter”).

1. Eligibility

1.1. The Awards are open to staff employed or contracted by those schools and colleges across the region who are eligible to work with Greater Manchester Higher. GM Higher’s work is concentrated on learners between the ages 13 to 18 (school years 9 - 13).

1.2. Employees of the Promoter or any associated company and their immediate family as well as their employees and judges of the Competition and their immediate family, or anyone else involved in the organisation of the Awards, are not eligible to enter the Competition.

2. How to enter

2.1. To enter the Awards Entrants must:

2.1.1. Make a nomination via the online entry forms provided by GM Higher. These are linked from the GM Higher website.

2.2. Entries must be received by close of business on 16th June 2021 to be valid. All required fields must be completed.

2.3. The Promoter shall not accept responsibility for Entries not received by the deadline.

2.4 All Entrants must comply with the competition instructions/guidance that will be provided by GM Higher via their social media platforms and website.

2.5. By entering this Competition both the nominee and nominator accept, agree and consent to:

2.5.1 . the use of your personal data by the Promoter for the purpose of administration of the Competition (including a photograph of the award winner(s), publishing the name of the winner and any administration relating to the Prize); and

2.5.2. the Promoter contacting you regarding your Entry and the potential use of your Entry (in which case further documentation will be issued).

3. Winner selection and contact

3.1. There are five different categories for the Lockdown Hero Awards. The winner of each category will receive a spend of £600 to be put towards Continuing Professional Development CPD activities.

3.2 The exception (to 3.1) is the ‘Careers Practitioner/Initiative’ award which is co-sponsored by Bridge GM. The award for this category is £1600 and this should be spent on a careers education and/or an HE outreach activity for learners. The funds need to be spent on addressing gaps in careers provision, and should focus on Gatsby benchmarks 4, 5 or 6.

3.3. The judges shall have absolute discretion to choose the winning Entry and the judges' decision shall be final. The full names of the judges are available upon written request to the Promoter. No correspondence will be entered into in respect of any decision made in connection with this Competition.

3.4. At the end of the Competition, the Competition Panel Lead shall contact the winners via the email addresses provided. Winners will be announced during week beginning 28/06/2021.

3.5 If the Prize is declined by a winner or is withdrawn from a winner, then the declining or forfeiting winner will continue to be subject to the provisions of these Conditions; and the Promoter may offer the Prize to a new winner selected by the Greater Manchester Higher team

4. Prize

4.1 The award money for each category should be spent on CPD, for use by the recipient of the award, or put to wider use for CPD by staff within their school/college. The CPD offer must demonstrate a connection with careers education and/or higher education outreach. For further

guidance around what may be permitted, please refer to Learning Outcomes for Teachers contained in the [GM Higher Regional Progression Framework](#) and the Learning Outcomes for Teachers.

4.2. This Prize is non-transferable and non-refundable. There is no alternative prize (cash or otherwise).

4.3 It is the responsibility of the award winners to inform, and agree with, GM Higher how the funds will be spent and provide details of the CPD provider. This should be done within a week of the winners being announced to allow funds for the CPD activity to transfer to the recipient's school or college by no later than 31/07/2021.

5. Entry requirements

5.1. Any Entry that is deemed by the Promoter, in its sole discretion, to be unlawful, obscene, vulgar, hateful, threatening, discriminatory, offensive or which may otherwise bring the Competition or Promoter into disrepute will be excluded from the Competition and the Promoter reserves the right to take any further action in respect of this.

6. Use and display of Entries and copyright

6.1. The copyright subsisting in the Entry must belong to the Entrant. Entrants will retain copyright in the Entries they submit. Entrants must not have infringed the rights of any other party or breached any laws when submitting their Entries.

7.2. By submitting an Entry:

7.2.1. you licence and grant the Promoter, the right to use the quotes, photograph (optional) and messages contained nomination form, and to contact you. Both the nominator and the nominee consent to sharing the above via, but not exclusive to, our website, social media platforms, print and digital marketing materials.

7.2.2. You waive any moral rights or similar rights in respect of your entry to which you may be entitled (at the time of submission or in the future) under any applicable laws in force anywhere in the world;

8. Liability

8.1. Except for death or personal injury caused by negligence of the Promoter or its agents or representatives or for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation, neither the Promoter, nor its agents or representatives assume responsibility for:

8.1.1. any Prize that is not redeemed;

8.1.5. any incomplete, or late Entries;

8.1.6. any failure to fulfil obligations of any third parties involved in this Competition;

8.1.7. any fault, malfunction, damage, injury, loss or disappointment suffered by the Entrants in the Competition howsoever arising;

8.1.8. any other matter outside of their reasonable control.

8.2. Nothing in these Conditions affects your statutory rights.

8.3. To the extent permitted by law, all conditions, warranties and other terms which might otherwise be implied by statute or common law are expressly excluded from these Conditions.

8.4. The Winner agrees to indemnify and keep indemnified the Promoter, its associated companies and their officers, employees and agents from and against all liabilities, losses, damages and expenses (including legal and other professional fees) arising out of or in connection with any allegations or claims resulting directly or indirectly from:

8.4.1. their Entry into this Competition; and/or

8.4.2. their receipt and use of any Prize.

9. General

9.1. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the Competition or these Conditions if it has reasonable grounds for doing so.
