## WHAT TO BRING

- You don't need to wear your school uniform, but please dress appropriately – remember you'll be going to court.

## WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Lunch, drinks and snacks will be provided. You're welcome to bring your own food if you prefer, but you don't have to.
- Money/valuables - again, you're welcome to bring things along, but there won't be much opportunity to go shopping, so don't bring too much along, just in case it goes missing.

## PARENT/CARER INFORMATION SESSION

There will be a Parent/Carer information session in advance of the event. We'll send an invitation email out in advance.

## TRAVEL

Transport will be arranged from your school to and from the University each day. We'll send out the exact timings in due course, but we expect there to be a morning pick up of approx. 8:00am, and a drop off of approx. 16:00. Due to the Graduation ceremony on day three, buses will be departing later.

# FAQs

## **Can I do anything to prepare for the summer school?**

You don't need to do anything; but if you want to do a bit of research ahead of time, just have a think about what sort of role you'd like to take in the trial – a daring defender? A perilous prosecutor? Or maybe a fearsome forensic analyst!

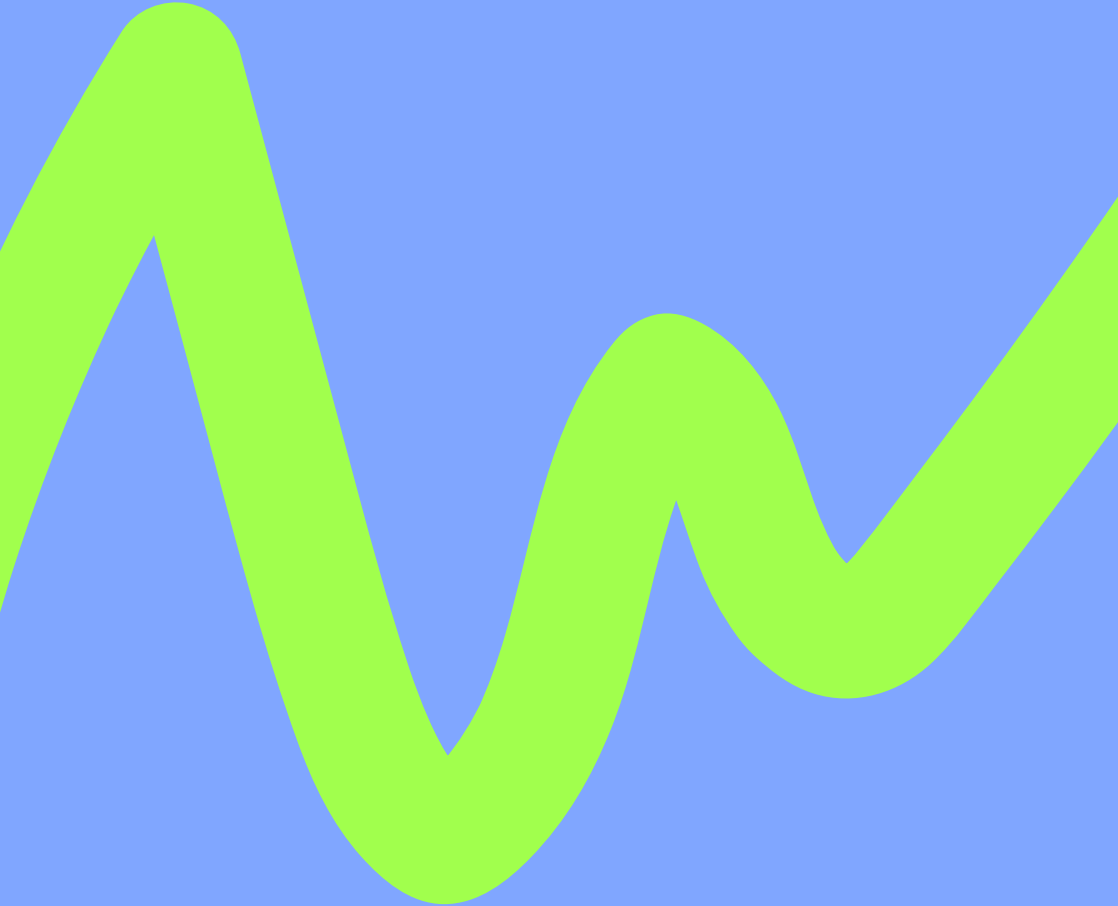
